ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY

On August 24, 1998, the Commission issued an Order Adopting Procedural Schedule which required that Timber Creek Sewer Company (TCSC) file its direct testimony by September 8, 1998 at 3:00 p.m. On September 17, 1998, the Commission entered an Order which extended the date for filing of direct testimony by TCSC to September 18, 1998.
