**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME**

The Commission issued an order directing the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to file a status pleading on October 13, 1998 advising the Commission whether Local Fone Service, Inc. (Local Fone) has complied with the approved stipulation of the parties. Staff filed a motion on October 13 asking for an extension of 45 days to enable Staff to obtain additional information. Staff stated that Local Fone had been fully cooperative in complying with the agreement but that additional confirmation needs to take place.

The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds the request is reasonable. Since the 45-day period ends one day after a state holiday, the due date will be extended to November 30, 1998.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the deadline for the Staff of the Commission to file a status pleading regarding this case is extended to November 30, 1998.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 19, 1998.
