ORDER DIRECTING COMPLIANCE

On August 27, 1998, the Commission issued an Order that granted Tel-Link, L.L.C. (Tel-Link) a certificate to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri. That Order also directed Tel-Link to file in the official case file the financial data submitted to the Staff of the Public Service Commission on July 22, 1998. The order also indicated that Tel-Link could request a Protective Order if needed.

Tel-Link filed a Motion for Protective Order on October 7 and the Commission issued the requested Protective Order on October 8. However, Tel-Link has not yet filed the financial data that it was directed to file.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

 That Tel-Link L.L.C. shall, no later than April 15, 1999, file in the official Case File the financial data submitted to Staff on July 22, 1998.

- 2. That Tel-Link L.L.C. is advised that failure to comply with an order of the Commission may subject it to the penalties set forth at Sections 386.570 and 386.580, RSMo (1994).
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on April 13, 1999.
