ORDER DIRECTING COMPLIANCE

On August 27, 1998, the Commission issued an Order that granted Tel-Link, L.L.C. (Tel-Link) a certificate to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri. That Order also directed Tel-Link to file in the official case file the financial data submitted to the Staff of the Public Service Commission on July 22, 1998. The order also indicated that Tel-Link could request a Protective Order if needed.

Tel-Link filed a Motion for Protective Order on October 7 and the Commission issued the requested Protective Order on October 8. However, Tel-Link has not yet filed the financial data that it was directed to file.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Tel-Link L.L.C. shall, no later than April 15, 1999, file in the official Case File the financial data submitted to Staff on July 22, 1998.

2. That Tel-Link L.L.C. is advised that failure to comply with an order of the Commission may subject it to the penalties set forth at Sections 386.570 and 386.580, RSMo (1994).

3. That this order shall become effective on April 13, 1999.
