On February 20, 2015¹, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois ("ATXI") asked the Commission to either find that it does not have jurisdiction over this project or, in the alternative, asked the Commission to grant ATXI a certificate of convenience and necessity to build it. The Commission granted ATXI's certificate on June 2. ATXI filed an application for rehearing on June 11, again claiming that the Commission does not have jurisdiction over the project.

The Commission will order the parties to respond as follows.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall respond to the application for rehearing no later than June 22, 2015.
2. Any other parties wishing to respond to the application for rehearing shall do so no later than June 22, 2015.

3. Any party who believes an evidentiary hearing is required shall also so state no later than June 22, 2015.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
