## **ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF**

Capital Network System, Inc. filed a Surrender of Certificate of Service Authority on September 9, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel its interexchange certificate and tariff, issued by the Commission on September 28, 1993, in Case No. TA-93-347. Capital Network System, Inc. surrendered its Missouri Certificate of Service Authority along with this filing. Capital Network System, Inc. stated it had no customers in Missouri, that surrender of its certificate was not detrimental to the public interest, and that it wished to have its certificate canceled.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Memorandum on September 24, 1998 regarding the proposed cancellation of Capital Network System, Inc.'s certificate and related tariff. Staff stated it had reviewed Capital Network System, Inc.'s application and had no objection to the Commission issuing an order canceling the certificate and related tariff previously issued to Capital Network System, Inc. Staff indicated it had contacted a Capital Network System, Inc. official who verbally confirmed the company had no customers in the State of Missouri.

Section 392.410 gives the Commission authority to cancel a telecommunications company's certificate of service authority. The Commission has reviewed Capital Network System, Inc.'s application, Staff's motion and recommendation, and the official file and finds that

the interexchange certificate and tariff granted to Capital Network System, Inc. in Case No. TA-93-347 shall be canceled.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the interexchange certificate and tariff granted to Capital Network System, Inc. in Case No. TA-93-347 are canceled.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on October 9, 1998.
  - 3. That this case shall be closed on October 13, 1998.
