ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND

On June 28, 1996, Ozark Telephone Company (Ozark) filed a modernization plan with the Commission stating that it would complete the modernization of its exchanges by December 31, 1997. That deadline was extended until December 31, 1998 by the Commission's order of September 25, 1997. On September 8, 1998, Ozark filed a motion asking for a further extension of time, until December 31, 1999, for completion of its modernization plan. Ozark's motion indicates that it is seeking the extension because of a delay in obtaining financing from Rural Utility Services. On October 23, 1998, Staff filed a response to Ozark's request for extension of time. Staff's response requests that the Commission deny Ozark's request for additional time to complete the modernization plan. On October 29, Ozark filed a motion requesting additional time in which to respond to Staff's response. Ozark asks that it be allowed until November 12 to prepare and file its response to Staff's response.

The Commission believes that Ozark's request for additional time in which to submit a response to Staff's response is reasonable.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Ozark Telephone Company's Request for Additional Time to File Response to Staff's Response is granted.
- 2. That Ozark Telephone Company's shall file its response to Staff's response no later than November 12, 1998.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on November 5, 1998.
