ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

TCG Kansas City/AT&T Corp. (TCG Kansas City) filed a Notice of Adoption on August 20, 1998, advising the Commission of its intention to adopt the approved interconnection agreement between Brooks Fiber and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT). The Commission issued an Order and Notice on September 1 giving notice to interested parties and advising any party wishing to request participation to make its request no later than September 21.

SWBT filed an Application to Intervene on September 16 stating that it had an interest in this case different from that of the general public since it is a party to the agreement.

The Commission has reviewed SWBT's application. Ordinarily, participation and not intervention is granted in a case involving an interconnection agreement. However, since SWBT is a party to the agreement at issue, the Commission finds that SWBT has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which justifies intervention rather than mere participation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Southwestern Bell Telephone Company is granted intervention in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on October 6, 1998.
