**ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME**  
**REQUEST FOR FILING OF ADOPTION NOTICE**

Century Telecommunications, Inc. (Century), submitted an Application for Approval of Name Change on November 9, 1998, designed to reflect that it will be operating under the fictitious name, CenturyTel Telecommunications, Inc. Century included with its filing a Registration of Fictitious Name and the Amended Certificate of Authority of a Foreign Corporation from the Missouri Secretary of State filed June 4, 1998.

The Commission has reviewed Century's filing and finds that the name change should be recognized. The Commission further finds that the adoption notice reflecting that fictitious name should be filed in the tariffs by Century.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the fictitious name "CenturyTel Telecommunications" is acknowledged.
2. That the adoption notice denominated P.S.C. MO No. 1, Adoption Notice should be filed by Century in the tariffs.

3. That this order shall become effective on the effective date of the adoption notice.
