ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS PURSUANT TO COMMISSION ORDER,
DENYING REHEARING AND DENYING MODIFICATION

The Commission issued its Report and Order in this matter on June 13, 1997. The Commission instructed Kansas City Power and Light Company (KCPL) to file revised tariffs in accordance with the Commission's Report and Order. On June 18 KCPL filed tariffs purporting to be in compliance with the Commission's order, bearing an effective date of July 13. On July 2 the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation stating that, after review, Staff is of the opinion that the proposed tariffs are in compliance with the Commission's order.

On July 1 intervenor Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation (Trigen-KC) filed a motion for modification of the proposed tariffs and rehearing of the Report and Order. Trigen-KC stated in its motion that the proposed tariffs are not in compliance with portions of the Commission's Report and Order and that, therefore, the tariffs should be modified or rejected.

On July 3 Staff informed the Commission that, after further review in light of the Trigen-KC motion, it was still of the opinion that the proposed tariffs are in full compliance with the Commission's Report and Order in this case.

On July 1 the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed an Application for Rehearing, stating that the Commission has erred in its Report and Order in its consideration of the facts of this case and in the findings regarding those facts. OPC requests a rehearing of various issues.

The Commission has reviewed the motions of both Trigen-KC and OPC and finds that it has considered all facts and evidence in its original decision in this case. The Commission finds no sufficient reason for reconsideration of its original decision. In addition, the Commission has reviewed the tariffs filed June 18 by KCPL and finds that they are reasonable and in full compliance with the Commission's order of June 13. The Commission will approve those tariffs for service on or after July 13.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariffs filed June 18, 1997, by Kansas City Power and Light Company, are hereby approved for service on or after July 13, 1997:


