ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE

That Place in Clarence submitted a letter to the Missouri Public Service Commission on April 30, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel its payphone certificate. That Place in Clarence was granted the certificate on September 25, 1996, in Case No. TA-97-87. The Staff of the Commission advised the Commission that it had made contact with the certificate holder and that the certificate should be canceled because the certificate holder had never installed nor operated a payphone.

Section 392.410, RSMo Supp. 1997 gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed That Place in Clarence's letter and Staff's comments and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to That Place in Clarence in Case No. TA-97-87 shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the private payphone certificate granted to That Place in Clarence in Case No. TA-97-87 is canceled.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on July 23, 1998.

3. That this case may be closed on July 24, 1998.
