ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE

Wendy Kanefield d/b/a/ WK Communications submitted a letter to the Missouri Public Service Commission on or about May 14, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel her payphone certificate. Wendy Kanefield was granted the certificate on December 27, 1996, in Case No. TA-97-172. The Staff of the Commission advised the Commission that it had made contact with the certificate holder and that the certificate should be canceled because Wendy Kanefield had sold her payphone business.

Section 392.410, RSMo Supp. 1997 gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Wendy Kanefield's letter and Staff's comments and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Wendy Kanefield in Case No. TA-97-172 shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the private payphone certificate granted to Wendy Kanefield in Case No. TA-97-172 is canceled.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on July 24, 1998.

3. That this case may be closed on July 27, 1998.
