ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

Pursuant to the Commission's informal rate procedure, Midland Water Company (Midland) filed tariffs on June 25, 1997 designed to increase total annual revenue for water service by \$6718, or 90 percent. The proposed tariffs currently bear an effective date of August 9. On July 28 the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a recommendation reflecting that Staff, Midland and the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) have agreed to the proposed rates.

In its recommendation Staff states that after completion of its investigation of the books, records and operations of Midland, there is justification for the proposed increase and recommends the increase be approved by the Commission.

Staff states that the following reflects the proposed tariffs and is a monthly bill comparison for a customer of Midland using 5,000 gallons of water per month:

Staff further recommends that the small company depreciation rates filed July 3 and appended to this order as Attachment A be approved by the Commission.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff filing, the Staff recommendation and accompanying documentation in the case file and finds the proposed annual increase to be reasonable and in the public interest together with the attached depreciation schedule. The Commission will approve the proposed tariffs and depreciation schedule for service on or after August 9.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff filed June 25, 1997 by Midland Water Company, Inc. is hereby approved for service on or after August 9, 1997:
