ORDER DIRECTING ADDITIONAL STAFF FILING

On September 16, 1998, the Commission ordered a Staff investigation into the facts surrounding this complaint. On October 23, Staff filed its Memorandum. That Memorandum did not address the allegation that Laclede improperly turned off the gas to the Complainant's residence. This is one of the most serious allegations in the complaint, and the Commission will direct Staff to supplement its memorandum with its findings concerning this allegation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall investigate the allegation that Respondent improperly turned off the gas to the Complainant's residence and shall file a report of its findings in this case no later than December 1, 1998.

2. That this order shall become effective on November 27, 1998.
