ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

The Commission received an application from Cellular Long Distance Service Corporation, a competitive telecommunications company, on April 24, 1997, requesting that the company's certificate of service authority be canceled and that its tariff be withdrawn. In its Memorandum filed on July 14, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) recommended that the Commission issue an order to cancel the company's certificate of service authority granted in Case No. TA-92-8 and accompanying tariffs.

Based upon the company's request and Staff's recommendation, the Commission will cancel the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff. The request indicates that all the company's subscribers were transferred to Ameritech or to other long distance carriers as of March 1, 1997.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Missouri and accompanying tariff of Cellular Long Distance Service Corporation are hereby canceled.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 29, 1997.
