ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION AND REJECTING TARIFF SHEETS

MICRO-COMM, INC. (Micro-Comm) filed an application with the Commission on September 10, 1997. Micro-Comm filed tariff sheets in association with its application carrying an effective date of October 27.

On September 30, the Commission issued its Order Suspending Tariff Sheets and Directing the Filing of an Amended Application in order to give Micro-Comm an opportunity to address numerous inconsistencies between the tariff and the allegations of the application and the caption of the case, as well as other deficiencies. The tariff was suspended until February 24, 1998, and Micro-Comm was permitted to file an amended application no later than October 30, 1997. Micro-Comm has not filed an amended application or responded in any other manner to the Commission's order of September 30.

The Commission finds that Micro-Comm's application and associated tariff are inadequate as filed, and that Micro-Comm has failed to take advantage of its opportunity to correct the deficiencies identified by the Commission. Accordingly, the Commission will dismiss Micro-Comm's application and reject Micro-Comm's tariff sheets on its own motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff, filed by MICRO-COMM, INC. on September 10, 1997, is rejected:

- 2. That MICRO-COMM, INC.'s application is dismissed.
- 3. That this order shall become effective on December 5, 1997.
- 4. That this case shall be closed on December 6, 1997.
