ORDER APPROVING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On September 12, 1997, the Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) filed Staff's Motion to File Report and To Adopt Procedural Schedule. The Commission has recently issued orders regarding the solution to the exhaustion of central office codes (NXXs) in the 816 numbering plan area (NPA). The Commission finds it is now appropriate to direct the parties to resume working on potential solutions for the impending exhaustion of NXXs in the 314 NPA.

The Staff's motion proposed the following procedural schedule for issues limited to the 314 NPA:

Simultaneous Direct Testimony

November 20, 1997

Simultaneous Rebuttal Testimony

December 11, 1997

Hearing Memorandum

December 12, 1997

Evidentiary Hearing

December 15 and 16, 1997

The filing of the hearing memorandum is the joint responsibility of all parties. However, the Staff of the Commission has the primary responsibility to ensure that the hearing memorandum is completed and filed in a timely manner. In order to facilitate this, the parties will be directed to submit their positions to the Staff General Counsel not less than 2 business days prior to the date upon which the hearing memorandum must be filed. In addition, the hearing memorandum shall contain an

appendix with definitions of any technical terms used within that document.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the proposed procedural schedule is adopted as set out below.
