ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On November 16, 1994, Four Seasons Lakesites Water & Sewer Company (Lakesites) filed an application seeking a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide water and sewer service in an unincorporated area of Camden and Miller Counties, Missouri, generally comprising the eastern half of the area known as Shawnee Bend.

An application to intervene was timely filed by Osage Water Company (Osage). In support of its application, Osage states it is affected by Lakesites' application in a manner different from that of the general public in that it has an existing water service area which adjoins Lakesites' proposed service area and it has a pending application before the Commission for authority to provide sewer service in an area which includes substantially all of Lakesites' proposed service area.

Upon review of Osage's application and Commission regulations, the Commission finds that Osage has an interest in this matter which is different from that of the general public. Thus, the Commission determines that Osage should be permitted to intervene as a party in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Osage Water company is hereby granted intervention in this case.
 - 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
