In the matter of the Application of CLD Co., for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services.

## ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On August 31, 1993, CLD Co. (CLD or Applicant) was granted a Certificate of Service Authority. Applicant was further ordered to file its proposed tariffs forthwith. In its initial Application, the Applicant requested expedited treatment and consented to the expedited schedule herein which was devised by the Commission Staff.

On August 31, 1993, Applicant filed its proposed tariff reflecting the rates, rules and regulations it intends to use in providing its competitive services in Missouri. A Staff recommendation was filed on August 31, 1993, in which the Commission Staff recommended that the Commission approve Applicant's tariff. Applicant is proposing to provide switched services including "1+" long distance service. The tariff filed reflects the statutory and regulatory requirements which were waived by the Commission. The tariffs also reflect the waiver of 4 CSR 240-33.040(5) regarding finance fees in addition to the rules for which waiver was granted in the Commission's Order Approving Interexchange Certificate of Service Authority. Staff recommends approval of the tariffs which include the additional waiver.

Having considered the Applicant's tariff and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff details services, equipment and pricing offered to all potential customers, and that the tariff is similar to the approved tariff for other Missouri certificated interexchange

carriers that provide similar services. The Commission finds that the waiver of 4 CSR 240-33.040(5) is also reasonable as this tariff has been waived for other interexchange carriers providing similar services. The Commission finds that the tariff sheets filed by Applicant on August 31, 1993 comply with the Commission's order and should be approved for service on and after September 1, 1993.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by CLD Co. on August 31, 1993 are hereby approved for service on and after September 1, 1993:
