# ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

This order approves Union Electric Company d/b//a AmerenUE's tariff sheets filed in compliance with the previous Commission order.

The Commission granted Gascosage Electric Cooperative and AmerenUE's joint application for approval of a change of supplier, sale of assets, and the amendment of a written territorial agreement on January 24, 2002. The order directed AmerenUE to file revised tariff sheets consistent with the amended territorial agreement. AmerenUE filed the required tariff sheets on February 20, 2002. On March 5, 2002, AmerenUE filed substitute sheets.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission reviewed the tariff sheets and filed a memorandum on March 8, 2002, recommending that the Commission approve the tariffs as amended. Staff stated that the tariff sheets comply with the Commission's Report and Order and should be approved to become effective on March 25, 2002.

Having reviewed the tariff sheets and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the tariff sheets conform to the Commission's order and should be approved to become effective as ordered below.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE on February 20, 2002, (File No. 200200672) are approved as amended to become effective on March 25, 2002. The tariff sheets approved are:
