ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On May 5, 1995, the Commission issued a Report and Order in Case No. EO-93-351, which approved a Stipulation and Agreement disposing of all issues relating to phase II of St. Joseph Light & Power Company's (SJLP or Company) electric class cost of service. The Report and Order also authorized SJLP to file revised electric, gas, and steam tariffs consistent with specimen tariffs attached to the Stipulation and Agreement. The specimen tariffs contained rate design changes designed to implement the class cost of service shifts agreed to in the stipulation, as well to implement shifts agreed to in another stipulation approved by the Commission. The other stipulation, which was approved by the Commission on February 10, 1995, in Case No. EO-94-36, provided that revenues from SJLP's steam operations would decrease by \$550,000, with recovery of the \$550,000 decrease in revenues shifted to SJLP's electric and gas operations instead. At the hearing on the stipulation in Case No. EO-93-351, counsel for SJLP noted the need for one correction to the specimen tariffs, to change the rate for billing cycles from October through May for each kilowatt less than or equal to the previous summer peak kilowatt from \$1.33 to \$1.34.

On May 16, 1995, SJLP filed tariff sheets for its electric, gas, and steam operations, to comply with the provisions of the Commission's Report and Order. On June 5, 1995, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed three separate memoranda containing Staff's recommendations regarding SJLP's revised electric, natural gas, and

steam tariffs. All three memoranda indicate that Staff has reviewed the proposed tariff sheets filed by SJLP, and is of the opinion that the filings are consistent with the specimen tariffs attached to the Stipulation and Agreement, and are in compliance with the Commission's Report and Order. Staff's memorandum relating to SJLP's proposed electric tariff sheets notes one deviation from the specimen tariffs, consisting of one rate on Schedule 311, which was modified and accepted during oral presentations on the stipulation at the hearing held on April 18, 1995. The electric tariff sheet memorandum also notes that at Staff's request, SJLP filed a substitute tariff sheet on May 25, 1995, to correct a textual error which was inadvertently overlooked on the initial tariff sheets submitted with the Stipulation and Agreement.

All three memoranda recommend approval of the respective tariff filings, contingent upon the approval of all three filings, and state that except for the respective two related filings, Staff is unaware of any issue pending before the Commission which affects or is affected by the electric, natural gas, and steam tariff filings. Staff recommends that the electric, natural gas, and steam tariff sheets filed by SJLP on May 16, 1995, including the substituted electric tariff sheet filed on May 25, 1995, be approved for service on and after the requested effective date of June 15, 1995.¹

The Commission finds that the Staff's recommendation is appropriate; that the revised electric, natural gas, and steam tariff sheets filed by SJLP comply with the Commission's Report and Order dated May 5, 1995; and that the rates contained in the tariff sheets are just and reasonable.

¹Per the Stipulation and Agreement approved in Case No. EO-93-351, certain of the electric tariff sheets are to have an effective date of January 1, 1996, in order to allow SJLP the necessary time to implement new billing procedures.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following electric tariff sheets filed by St. Joseph Light & Power Company on May 16, 1995, as substituted on May 25, 1995, are hereby approved to become effective June 15, 1995:

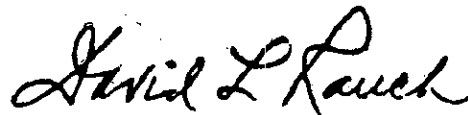
