ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

On February 28, 1992, Cassidy Water Company (Cassidy) filed an application seeking Commission approval to sell and transfer its sewer franchise, works and system to the City of Fremont Hills, Missouri. On June 2, 1992, the Commission issued an order authorizing the sale of the sewer works and determined that the certificate of convenience and necessity should be cancelled after notification by Cassidy that the transfer had been completed. On May 3, 1993, Cassidy filed notification that the sale of the sewer works by Cassidy to the City of Fremont was closed April 22, 1993, with the transfer effective that date.

The Commission determines that the certificate of convenience and necessity issued to Cassidy Water Company should be cancelled as the transfer of its sewer franchise has been completed and the City of Fremont Hills, Missouri, began operation of the system on April 22, 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the certificate of convenience and necessity issued to Cassidy Water Company be, and is, hereby cancelled.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on May 28, 1993.
