ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AND TARIFF

On September 7, 1993, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order in the above-styled case which approved the sale and transfer of all of the franchise, works, or sewer system of Progress Unlimited, Inc., d/b/a Hill-Shine Community Water and Sanitation Company (Hill-Shine) to The Calvey Creek Public Sewer District of Franklin County, Missouri (Calvey Creek) pursuant to an Agreement To Purchase Assets between Hill-Shine and Calvey Creek. In Ordered Section 3 of the Order Approving Sale and Transfer of Assets, the Commission ordered Hill-Shine to file a pleading notifying the Commission of the closing date of the sale and transfer of assets within five days after its completion, and in Ordered Section 4 the Commission indicated that it would cancel the certificate of convenience and necessity held by Hill-Shine, along with Hill-Shine's current tariff, upon receipt of the pleading affirming the closing of the sale and transfer.

On February 16, 1994, Hill-Shine filed a letter indicating that all property, operation, customers, and responsibility pertaining to its sewer system was conveyed to Calvey Creek effective February 14, 1994. The Commission finds that the information contained in the letter is sufficient to comply with the Commission's order, and that Hill-Shine's certificate of convenience and necessity and current tariff should therefore be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of convenience and necessity and current tariff of Progress Unlimited, Inc., d/b/a Hill-Shine Community Water and Sanitation Company be and is hereby cancelled.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
