ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On June 6, 1997, Garrold Hambelton (Petitioner) submitted a written request with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) explaining that he wished to cancel his certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service that was previously granted to him under the fictitious name Kay-Lynn.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum containing its recommendation on February 5, 1998. Staff states that Petitioner was certificated by the Commission to provide private pay telephone service on July 5, 1995, in Case No. TA-95-391. Staff attempted to contact Petitioner to confirm the cancellation request but was unable to reach him. Based upon Petitioner's request, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service previously granted to Petitioner.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's recommendation, and finds that it would be appropriate to cancel the certificate of service authority.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service granted to Garrold Hambelton d/b/a Kay-Lynn on

July 5, 1995, in Case No. TA-95-391 is canceled.

- 2. That this order shall become effective on March 9, 1998.
- 3. That this case shall be closed on March 10, 1998.
