ORDER CLOSING DOCKETS

On August 29, 1991, a natural gas incident occurred in Madison, Missouri. On September 10, 1991, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion to establish a docket. On September 18, 1991, the Commission established Case No. GS-92-33 for the purpose of receiving Staff's report on the incident discussed herein.

On January 16, 1992, Staff filed a Gas Incident Report in Case No. GS-92-33 containing several recommendations to the involved operator, the Madison Municipal Gas System. Also on January 16, 1992, Staff filed a complaint against the City of Madison, Missouri, which was docketed as Case No. GC-92-166. On February 20, 1992, the City of Madison filed a response to Staff's recommendations in Case No. GS-92-33.

On March 16, 1992, Staff and the City of Madison filed a Stipulation and Agreement reflecting an agreement between the parties in Case Nos. GS-92-33 and GC-92-166. On March 24, 1992, the Commission issued an Order Approving

Stipulation and Agreement which, in part, ordered that after Staff received "acceptable proof of acquisition of the equipment and acceptable proof of training in the use of the equipment" from the City of Madison, Staff was to file a memorandum requesting that both dockets be closed.

On July 1, 1992, Staff filed a memorandum recommending that Case Nos. GS-92-33 and GC-92-166 be closed. Staff stated that it has received acceptable proof that the City of Madison had acquired the proper equipment and that personnel have been trained in the use of the equipment. Staff also stated that no further formal action is required of Staff or the City of Madison.

Based upon Staff's recommendation, the Commission has determined that Case Nos. GS-92-33 and GC-92-166 should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Case No. GS-92-33 is hereby closed.
- 2. That Case No. GC-92-166 is hereby closed.
- 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
