ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On February 26, 2002, the Commission approved the parties' settlement embodied in their Joint Stipulation and Agreement. That agreement provided in part for an inspection of the subject unit no later than February 15, 2002, and the subsequent filing of a report of the results of that inspection. On March 11, noting that that report had not been filed, the Commission directed its Staff to advise it of a date certain on which the report would be filed. On March 21, the Director responded, informing the Commission that he had not yet received the report and further stating that, "[u]nless the Director receives, by March 28, 2002, either an inspection report or a statement from the homeowners that they do not want the Respondent to complete the work, he will file a motion to set a procedural schedule for this case."

Over 30 days have passed since March 28 and the Director has not acted. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to file a status report in this case, including a

recommendation as to an appropriate course of action for the future. The status report should include information as to whether or not the settlement agreement of the parties has been implemented by the Respondent and whether or not the underlying consumer complaint has been satisfied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its status report, no later than 4:00 p.m. on May 10, 2002, including a recommendation as to a course of action that will lead to the prompt resolution of this matter.
2. That this order shall become effective on May 10, 2002.
