ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

On June 22, 1995, Brian P. Miller, d/b/a Total Image Remodeling, filed an application for change of electric service supplier.

- 1. That the application filed by Brian P. Miller, d/b/a Total Image Remodeling, be, and is hereby, dismissed for want of prosecution.
