Implementation Team Contact - CenturyTel designated Chris Czeschin as our rep / Account Coordinator - (This is who Socket will submit forecasts, go to w/ questions, issues, performance measurements, etc.) Chris needs to send a formal notice that he is the contact per Article XV.

CenturyTel has met all notice, procedure and process requirements contained in the Agreement.

Socket asked that we provide them information on pricing for 911 and and trunking changes. (Susan and Charles)

Socket is reviewing intrastate special access and interstate dedicated trunking to determine how we should convert Spectra trunking. (Matt Kohly)

Socket requested that they receive a separate access bill for EELs. (Charles) Socket requested a separate access bill for 911 trunks. (Charles)

Socket requested that we give them a breakdown of the DS1 interstate NRCs. (Charles to provide to Susan)

Generic Door Hangers - Operations needs to meet internally to make sure that this has been implemented and the field understands the requirements. (Darrell Robinson)

From Socket:

- 1) CLEC profile Socket will have this updated and provide it prior to the call. Socket will be able to answer any questions about it. We have received.
- 2) Branson Interconnect forecast to follow shortly from Socket received
- 3) What to do with existing Spectra interconnects will will convert to Special Access -
- 4) Socket has some general forecasting questions as far as forecasting UNEs and resold circuits. (Discussed Socket to provide)
- 5) Obtaining network information regarding the exchange of Columbia and Wentzville such as what general areas are covered by each wire center. This is necessary to be able to evaluate establishing additional interconnections in these exchanges and to meet our forecasting obligations. Need Socket to explain what they are needing. LERG will help them with NXXs. Are you asking for geographic areas? Have to check w/ Assignment Do they have a map showing geographic area? 882, 884, 771 belong to the University.

Pair gain remotes and where multiple central offices exist in a rate center - Socket needs geographic network information - is there a map that would give them this information - CenturyTel needs to determine what we can provide. (Chris Czeschin will follow-up on this)
