**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION**

On April 3, 2006, Taneycomo Highlands, Inc. filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission revised tariff sheets to implement increases in its sewer service rates and charges. The tariff sheets carry an effective date of April 30, 2006. Taneycomo's transmittal letter submitted with its tariff indicated the changes contained in the subject revised tariff sheets were based upon an Unanimous Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Sewer Company Rate Increase Request entered into by the Company, the Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel.

On April 6, 2006, the Staff filed a Notice of Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Company Rate Increase Request. In its notice the Staff acknowledged the existence of an agreement regarding the disposition of Taneycomo's rate increase request, and indicated that the Staff would file its recommendation regarding the small company rate increase request no later than the end of business on April 19, 2006.

The Staff did not file a recommendation regarding Taneycomo's tariff filing on or before April 19, 2006. The Commission determines that a response from the Staff would aid it in making its decision.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding Taneycomo Highlands, Inc.'s rate increase request, no later than April 21, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on April 21, 2006.
