Most of the issues in this case have been resolved by a stipulation and agreement that the Commission has approved. One issue remains for decision, and a hearing regarding that issue will take place on October 31, 2018. A provision of the approved stipulation and agreement states that the signatory parties stipulate to the admission of the testimony of their witnesses into the evidentiary record.¹
