## ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Effective Date: October 15, 2018

On October 12, 2018, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, the Staff of the Commission, Renew Missouri Advocates, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy, the Natural Resources Defense Council, and the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Third Stipulation and Agreement that would resolve all but one narrow issue. The Sierra Club, the only other party to this case, did not sign, but the agreement represents that it will not oppose the stipulation and agreement.

Along with the stipulation and agreement, the parties filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend the remainder of the procedural schedule. That motion indicates the remaining unresolved issue should be addressed based on prefiled testimony and a one-day evidentiary hearing, along with post-hearing briefing.

The remaining procedural schedule established for this case is:

Although most issues have purportedly been resolved by the Third Stipulation and Agreement, one issue remains. The Commission will still need a list of issues and statements of position regarding that issue. Consequently, the remaining procedural schedule cannot be suspended, although it will be modified to limit the hearing to just one day instead of four. Further, the post-hearing briefing schedule will be eliminated. The time needed to prepare and file briefs will be determined after discussion with the parties at the hearing.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The remaining procedural schedule is modified to provide as follows:

- List of Issues, Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross-Examination, Order of Opening** - **October 16, 2018**
- Statements of Position** - **October 23, 2018**
- Hearing** - **October 30, 2018, beginning at 9:00 a.m.**

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
