On October 26, 2009, Four Seasons Racquet and Country Club Condominium Property Owners Association, Inc. (“Four Seasons”) filed an application to intervene in the above captioned matters. In its application, Four Seasons argues that it should not be subject to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), or to the extent that it is subject to the rule, it seeks a waiver. Because there are a limited number of days between Four Seasons’ filing and the scheduled prehearing conference, and because there are a limited number of Agenda sessions scheduled between those dates for the Commission to consider Four Seasons’ request, the Commission will shorten the time for responses to the application.

1. Any party wishing to respond to the Four Seasons Racquet and Country Club Condominium Property Owners Association, Inc.'s application to intervene shall file its response no later than October 30, 2009.
