ORDER SETTING ON-THE-RECORD PROCEEDING

The evidentiary hearings for these matters was suspended on February 25, 2010, because Staff filed a joint status report on behalf of all the parties indicating that no party is seeking evidentiary hearings in these matters. Consequently, the Commission is reviewing the disposition agreements filed by Staff and the companies. To aid the Commission's determination on whether to approve those agreements the Commission will schedule an on-the-record presentation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. An on-the-record proceeding is scheduled for Friday, March 12, 2010, beginning at 10:00 a.m. The proceeding will be held in Room 310 of the Governor

Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri; a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any party requiring additional accommodations to participate shall call the Public Service Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 before the proceeding.

2. The parties shall be prepared to provide a complete explanation of the Disposition Agreements and their terms and conditions.

3. If any party intends to tender expert witnesses at the on-the-record proceeding scheduled for March 12, 2010, they shall file a pleading disclosing the identity and biographical background of those experts no later than March 10, 2010.

4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
