## LATE FILED ATTACHMENTS TO UNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), in behalf of all the parties to the above captioned case, and submits late filed attachments to the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (Stipulation) filed in this matter on June 10, 2004. In support of this filing, the Staff states as follows:

1. On June 23, 2004, the Commission issued an Order, which, among other things, directed the Staff to appear at the Commission's agenda meeting on July 8, 2004, to answer the Commission's questions regarding the Stipulation filed by the parties on June 10, 2004 concerning the Timber Creek Sewer Company's (Company) Request for a Small Company Rate Increase. The Commission's Order also provided that any other party to the case could appear and address the Commission regarding this case at this agenda meeting.

2. In an effort to assist the Commission regarding the background of the Stipulation filed in this matter, the Staff has prepared three attachments that are numbered S1, S2 and S3 respectively. These attachments were circulated among the parties on July 7, 2004, and no objections were offered either to their filing or for agenda discussion on July 8, 2004.

3. Attachment S1, is a history of the Company's customer rates; Attachment S2 is a comparison of the Company's plant in service in the current case as compared to its plant in service at the time of a previous small company rate increase request in the year 2000; and Attachment S3 is a comparison of the Staff's income statement for the Company in the current

case as compared to the income statement from the previous small company rate increase request in the year 2000. As is noted on Attachment S1, the Company did not receive a rate increase as a result of the above-referenced small company rate increase request.

4. 4 CSR 240-2.050(3)(A) provides the Commission with discretion to modify its Orders relating to the time of compliance therewith and by reasonable implication permits the receipt of late filed information. This should be especially true since there is no objection to receipt of the proffered information.

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff respectfully requests that the Commission consider and accept late filed Attachments S1 through S3 in this case.
