### ORDER APPROVING EXPEDITED TARIFF SHEETS IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

Issue Date: September 29, 2006 Effective Date: September 30, 2006

Syllabus: This order approves on an expedited basis the tariff sheets filed in compliance with a Commission order by Agua Missouri, Inc.

On September 28, 2006, the Commission issued an order that authorized Aqua Missouri to withdraw and refile tariff sheets designed to implement the terms of an agreement between the company, Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel. The agreement also stated that the signatories did not object to the tariffs becoming effective on an expedited basis. The Commission's order further found that good cause exists to make the refiled tariff sheets effective on less than 30 days notice. On September 29, 2006, Aqua Missouri withdrew and refiled its tariff sheets in compliance with the Commission's order.

The Commission has reviewed Aqua Missouri's tariff filing and finds that the tariff sheets are in compliance with the Commission's order and shall be approved as ordered below. The Commission has previously found that good cause exists to approve these tariffs on an expedited basis.

1. Tariff No. YS-2007-0214 as submitted on September 29, 2006, is hereby

approved on an expedited basis for service to be rendered on or after September 30, 2006.
