**ORDER DIRECTING TUCKER SHELL, LLC
TO FILE A RESPONSE**

On February 8, 2011, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an answer to the above complaint. With its answer, Ameren also filed a motion to dismiss the complaint.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) requires that responsive pleadings be filed within 10 days, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. The 10-day response time expired on February 18 and Tucker Shell, LLC did not file a response to Ameren's motion to dismiss.

Rather than dismiss this complaint without the benefit of Complainant's response to the motion, the Commission will enlarge the 10-day time frame and direct Complainant to file a response to the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The 10-day response time, set out in Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15), is enlarged.
2. Tucker Shell, LLC shall file a response to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's motion to dismiss no later than March 4, 2011.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
