Dear, Mr. Bales:

Socket Telecom, LLC ("Socket") disputes CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC's ("CenturyTel") position that Socket has existing Points of Interconnection (POI) with CenturyTel in the exchanges of O'Fallon, St. James, St. Peters, Troy, and Warrenton that are to be treated as existing POIs established pursuant to Article V, Section 4.3 of the Interconnection Agreement (ICA) that is in effect between Socket and CenturyTel. Socket also disputes CenturyTel's assertion that Socket is required to follow the process set forth in Article V, Section 4.3.5 in order to cease maintaining a POI in each of these five exchanges. Setting these disputes aside and without waiving any rights to continue to dispute these and other related issues, this letters serves as Notice to CenturyTel of Socket's intent to decommission the alleged POIs for each of these exchanges on the grounds that the volume of traffic exchanged between the Parties for each of these exchanges is below the applicable POI thresholds as is required by Article V, Section 4.3.5. Socket intends to decommission these alleged POIs in 90 days or upon earlier receipt of CenturyTel's notice to Socket that CenturyTel has reprovisioned trunking.

As previously discussed, Socket is willing to agree to direct trunking for each of these exchanges when traffic volumes exceeds a DS1. With this direct trunking, Socket and CenturyTel can establish direct trunking to a particular exchange even though the POI may be in Wentzville where each Party's facilities physically connect. In this direct trunking scenario, each Party will be financially responsible for its facilities on its side of the POI.
