Settlement discussions should not interfere with day to day operations. Regardless of what is discussed or agreed upon as part of any settlement, Socket has the right to interconnect on a direct or indirect basis with Spectra. Settlement discussions do not change Spectra's obligations. We

are now approaching a month since I first requested a meeting to discuss this interconnect. Spectra has been unwilling to discuss it and is apparently simply refusing to directly interconnect.

Lastly, I received an e-mail from Guy Miller indicating that settlement discussions should be put on hold until the PSC reaches a decision in the number porting complaint. We have no idea when that will be. Based upon

that e-mail, I am not at all certain that settlement discussions are ongoing. If they are ongoing, the ball is in CTEL's court to respond to Socket's last offer.
