

Amendment to
Interconnection Agreement
between
Sprint Communications Company L.P.
and
Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri

Pursuant to this Amendment (the "Amendment") Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint"), a Delaware Limited Partnership, and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri¹ ("AT&T"), hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties" hereby agree to amend that certain Interconnection Agreement between the Parties approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission on August 5, 2005, as amended ("the Agreement").

WHEREAS, Sprint and AT&T agree to amend the Agreement as set forth herein;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual provisions contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Sprint and AT&T hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Parties agree to delete Section 5.2, General Terms and Conditions in its entirety and replace it with the following:

5. EFFECTIVE DATE, TERM AND TERMINATION

5.2 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Agreement, the term of this Agreement shall commence upon the Effective Date of the Agreement and shall expire on November 21, 2011 (the "Term"). Absent the receipt by one Party of written notice from the other Party at least 180 calendar days prior to the expiration of the Term to the effect that such Party does not intend to extend the Term, this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect on and after the expiration of the Term until terminated by either Party pursuant to Section 5.3 or 5.4. Until November 21, 2011, this Agreement may be terminated only via Sprint's

¹ On December 30, 2001, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (a Missouri corporation) was merged with and into Southwestern Bell Texas, Inc. (a Texas corporation) and, pursuant to Texas law, was converted to Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., a Texas limited partnership. On June 29, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., a Texas limited partnership, was merged with and into SWBT Inc., a Missouri corporation, with SWBT Inc. as the survivor entity. Simultaneous with the merger, SWBT Inc. changed its name to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company is doing business in Missouri as "AT&T Missouri".

request unless terminated pursuant to a default provision within this Agreement.

2. All other provisions of this Agreement, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Either or both of the Parties are authorized to submit this Amendment to the appropriate Commission for approval subject to section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
4. This Amendment shall be filed with and is subject to approval by the Commission and shall be effective upon the date of the last signature of both Parties.
