ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION, ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT, AND ORDER SETTING PERMANENT RATES

Issue Date: November 27, 2007 Effective Date: December 1, 2007

On October 30, 2007, the Commission issued an Order Approving Small Company Rate Increase on an Interim Basis, Subject to Refund, and Approving Tariff. In that order the Commission set as interim all the rates, including the connection fee, of Timber Creek Sewer Company.

On November 8, 2007, Timber Creek filed a motion asking the Commission to reconsider its decision to set all the rates on an interim basis. Timber Creek requested that only the Contribution-in-Aid-of-Construction fee (connection fee) remain an interim rate and that the regular utility rates be set as permanent effective December 1, 2007. Timber Creek pointed out that the Commission recognized in its order that with "the exception of the connection fee, no party has objected to the residential rates or the revenue requirement as set out in the October 19, 2007 tariff revision," and that "the amount of the connection fee does not affect the revenue requirement or rate design." Timber Creek stated that no party opposes its motion.

The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds it reasonable. Because the only rate that remains in dispute is the connection fee, it is reasonable to set all the rates on a permanent basis with that one exception. Therefore, the Commission shall grant the motion for reconsideration and for expedited relief.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The motion for reconsideration and motion for expedited treatment filed by Timber Creek Sewer Company on November 18, 2007, are granted.
- With the exception as set out in ordered paragraph 3 below, the proposed tariff sheets filed by Timber Creek Sewer Company on September 14, 2007, as amended on October 19, 2007, Tariff No. YS-2008-0171, shall be approved to become effective on a permanent basis on December 1, 2007.
- 3. The Contribution-in-Aid-of-Construction fee set out in Tariff File No. YS-2008-0171 shall remain interim, subject to refund, until further decision of the Commission.
 - This order shall become effective on December 1, 2007. 4.
