On March 30, Staff filed a copy of the Disposition Agreement, along with attachments consisting of various other documents related to the agreement. Staff further pointed out that on March 14, Staff and WPC had already consented in writing to an extension of the 150-day tariff filing period that normally applies to small sewer company rate increase requests, and that this document had been filed in Tracking File No. QS-2007-0005. Finally, Staff indicated that it would be able to file its recommendation in this matter by close of business on April 13.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Commission acknowledges that the parties have timely filed both the Disposition Agreement and their written consent to the extension of the 150-day filing requirement contained in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.330(1)(F).
2. The date by which the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its recommendation regarding the Disposition Agreement and the associated tariff is modified from April 9, 2007 to April 13, 2007.
3. This order shall become effective on April 2, 2007.
