MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and files this Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") and states as follows:

1. On August 29, 2013,¹ the Commission issued its *Order Amending Procedural Schedule*. The *Order* changed the location of the evidentiary hearing at the request of the Complainant. The other provisions of the parties' proposed procedural schedule remained effect as approved by the Commission on August 28.

2. Since the filing of the procedural schedule, a conflict has arisen in the undersigned's availability due to travel to attend a family funeral.

3.
