The Missouri Public Service Commission would rather not approve an increase in the rates charged by Mill Creek Sewers, Inc., while the company is under financial control by Joseph Afshari. However, the Commission is aware that transfer of this responsibility is not probable prior to October 12, 2005, the effective date of the company's tariff reflecting an increase in rates. Mill Creek has discussed with the Commission the possibility of Testing Analysis and Control, the company now contracted to operate Mill Creek, also contracting to handle the financial aspects of Mill Creek. In light of this possibility, the Commission will require that Mill Creek file a pleading setting forth the content of any discussions it has had with Testing Analysis and Control.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Mill Creek Sewers, Inc., shall file with the Missouri Public Service Commission, not later than September 28, 2005, a pleading as described in the body of this order.

2. That this order shall become effective on September 27, 2005.
