On May 27, 2014, Consumers Council of Missouri, Office of the Public Counsel, and the Missouri Retailers Association filed a motion asking the Commission to reconsider or clarify its order regarding the complainant’s motion to establish a test year. By rule, other parties have ten days to respond to the motion, unless the Commission establishes a different time for response. So that it will be able to address the motion at its June 11 agenda session, the Commission will establish a shortened response date for anyone wishing to respond to that motion.

1. Any response to Consumers Council of Missouri, Office of the Public Counsel, and the Missouri Retailers Association’s Motion for Reconsideration or Clarification shall be filed no later than June 5, 2014.
