## **ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On March 31, 2005, LW Sewer Corporation filed revised tariff sheets effective May 1. On April 26, the Commission suspended the tariffs until May 31.

The Commission suspended the tariffs because, according to the Staff of the Commission, LW Sewer had not filed its 2004 Annual Report by its due date, April 15. The Commission's Electronic Filing Information System shows that LW Sewer filed that report on April 25.

The Commission notes that LW Sewer, Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel reached an agreement. That agreement included a provision that Staff would file a Recommendation regarding that agreement.

In that Recommendation, the Commission will order Staff to address why the annual report was late, and what remedy, if any, the Commission should pursue. Also, the Commission will order Staff to explain how the parties arrived at the \$600 connection charge.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its Recommendation, including an explanation of why LW Sewer Corporation's 2004 Annual

Report was late, what remedy, if any, the Commission should pursue, and including an explanation of how the parties arrived at the \$600 connection charge, no later than May 13, 2005.

- That the Office of the Public Counsel may respond no later than May 18,
   2005.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on April 27, 2005.
