## ORDER ADMITTING LATE-FILED EXHIBIT AND CLOSING RECORD

On March 10, 2011, the Commission gave notice that it would close the record and set a response deadline for filings that were made on March 4, 2011. Timber Creek Sewer Company was the only party filing a response. In its response, Timber Creek states: (1) it has no objection to Staff's position on the inclusion of rate case expenses for the period from February 1, 2011 through February 25, 2011; (2) it will drop its request for expenses for a separate customer notice if the Commission finds that notice can be provided as part of a billing statement; and (3) it requests an Accounting Authority Order ("AAO") to allow it to recover additional legal expenses associated with this case as part of a future action.

Regarding the March 4, 2011 filings, the Commission's Staff submitted the affidavit of V. William Harris verifying Timber Creek's rate case expenses incurred between February 1, 2011 through February 25, 2011 along with a copy of the statement for those legal services. Because no objections were made to this offering, the Commission marks this affidavit and accompanying documentation as Exhibit 30 and will receive this late-filed exhibit into the record.

With regard to Timber Creek's request for an AAO, the Commission will open a separate file to process that request. This record, as previously noticed, will be closed.

- 1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission's late-filed exhibit, Exhibit Number 30, as described in the body of this order, is admitted and received into the record.
  - 2. The record in File No. SR-2010-0320 is closed.
