In the matter of the application of
Stoddard County Sewer Co., Inc., for
permission, approval, and a certificate
of public convenience and necessity
authorizing it to construct, install,
own, operate, control, manage and
maintain a sewer system for the public
located in an unincorporated area in
Stoddard County, Missouri; this is to
extend service area boundaries only.

ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATE

On February 5, 1986, Stoddard County Sewer Co., Inc. (Applicant) filed its application seeking extension of its certificate of public convenience and necessity to permit service to an enlarged service area. The map filed with the application shows the proposed area to be relatively small, and adjacent to the Applicant's present service area.

By order of the Commission issued February 11, 1986, the Applicant has served notice of the application on the only three landowners in the proposed service area. The Commission also established an intervention date of March 13, 1986, and provided notice of the application to the County Commission of Stoddard County. No parties have intervened and there have been no requests for a hearing in this matter.

The Commission Staff has recommended that the requested certificate be granted because the proposed service area will be served with no capital investment and the company will be able to serve the proposed area utilizing existing rates. It is the Staff's opinion that the additional revenue will make the company healthier and will benefit existing customers.

The Commission has considered the application, the supporting documents and the Staff's recommendation, and has determined that the proposed extension of the Applicant's service area should be approved.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That Stoddard County Sewer Co., Inc., is hereby granted a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct and operate a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area in Stoddard County, Missouri, more fully described as follows:

The North One-half ($NE\frac{1}{2}$) of the East One-Fourth ($E\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 29, Township 25 North of the Base Line, Range 10 East of the Fifth Principal Meridian, containing five (5) acres, more or less.

ALSO

Part of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 29, Township 25 North, Range 10 East described as follows: Start at the Northeast corner of Section 29, Township 25 North, Range 10 East; Thence South $89^{\circ} 16' 45''$ West along and with the North section line 331.23 feet for a point of beginning; Thence South $0^{\circ} 29' 30''$ East 557.87 feet; Thence South $89^{\circ} 14' 37''$ West 35.45 feet; Thence North $1^{\circ} 54' 37''$ West 558 feet to the section line; Thence North $89^{\circ} 16' 45''$ East 49.27 feet to the point of beginning; Containing 0.54 acres subject to any easements that may exist.

ORDERED: 2. That within thirty (30) days from the effective date of this order, the Stoddard County Sewer Co., Inc., shall file revisions to its tariff reflecting the addition to its service area.

ORDERED: 3. That this order shall become effective on the 19th day of May, 1986.
