ORDER SCHEDULING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING

On September 26, 2001, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Warren County Water and Sewer Company and Gary L. Smith. Public Counsel also requested that the Commission hold a local public hearing.

The Commission will schedule a local public hearing to allow affected customers the opportunity to comment. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission will be available for a half-hour before the beginning of the local public hearing in order to provide neutral information about the issues to be considered by the Commission in this proceeding.

The Information Office of the Commission will be directed to provide notice to the members of the General Assembly who represent Warren County, and to the

newspapers, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current **Official Manual of the State of Missouri**, that serve Warren County.

Because of the difficulty encountered in making arrangements to use the clubhouse at Incline Village, there is insufficient time to allow mailing notice directly to customers. The Commission encourages Public Counsel to make the residents at Incline Village aware of the local public hearing by contacting the Board of Trustees of Incline Village and suggesting that notices be posted in Incline Village.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That a local public hearing shall be held on March 11, 2002, beginning at 6:00 P.M. in the clubhouse at Incline Village, a building that meets the accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- 2. That notice shall be provided by the Information Officer of the Public Service Commission as discussed herein.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on March 11, 2002.
