TradeWind supports the adoption of the procedural recommendations submitted on April 22, 2015, by Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC in its Recommendation Regarding Procedure to Address Information Filed by Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC (the "Grain Belt Recommendation").
