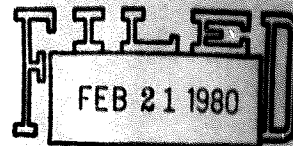
COMES NOW the applicant Water's Edge Sewer Company pursuant to Section 393.170 Revised Statutes of Missouri and in support of its application states:

1. Applicant is a Missouri corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri with its principal office and place of business at 701 Lake of the Woods Road, Post Office Box 1221, Columbia, Missouri 65205. Said corporation is a public utility proposing to render sewer service to the public under the jurisdiction of this Commission. A copy of its Certificate of Incorporation and Articles of Incorporation are attached to this application as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein.

3. Applicant requests permission and approval and a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area in Boone

County, Missouri as set forth on the map attached to this application as Exhibit 2 and legally described by meets and bounds in the legal description attached to this application as Exhibit 3, both of which exhibits are incorporated herein.

4. That a feasibility study has been completed and is attached to this application as Exhibit 4 and incorporated herein.

5. There are no municipalities located within the proposed area. The Boone County Court does not issue franchises for the operation of sewer companies. A letter from the Boone County Court is attached to this application and made a part hereof as Exhibit 5.


6. Said sewer system meets all requirements of the Commission and the Department of Natural Resources. This corporation has submitted its application and plans to the Department of Natural Resources as shown by the attached Exhibit 6 and is incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

7. There are no other public utilities or governmental bodies being operated or rendering service within the area proposed to be served except Boone Water and Waste^{Treatment} Co., Inc. The said Boone Water and Waste^{Treatment} Co., Inc. is not operating in the entire proposed service area of this applicant but does have a certificate covering approximately fifty-one (51) acres and is actually serving an area of approximately thirty (30) acres. The said Boone Water and Waste Co., Inc. facilities are inadequate and said facilities are not up to standards of the Department of Natural Resources. The Department of Natural Resources, through its representatives, has requested this applicant to serve the entire area covered by this application. It is anticipated by the time this application is heard, the certificate of the Boone Water and Waste^{Treatment} Co., Inc. will have been abandoned; but if such

is not the case, this applicant is willing to amend its application herein to exclude any portions of its proposed service area for which a certificate already exists.

8. The area requested is rapidly being developed into lots and subdivisions by developers and plans are being made to build residential homes and other establishments within the area, all of which will need adequate sewer service. A public need, therefore, exists for adequate sewer service within the proposed area and the public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting of the authority herein requested. Applicant has attached a list of the names and addresses of ten residents or owners of land in the proposed service area as Exhibit 7, which exhibit is incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests the Commission to grant its permission and approval and a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to install, acquire, build, construct, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system for the public within the area referred to in paragraph 3 hereof and for such further orders as the Commission may deem just and proper.

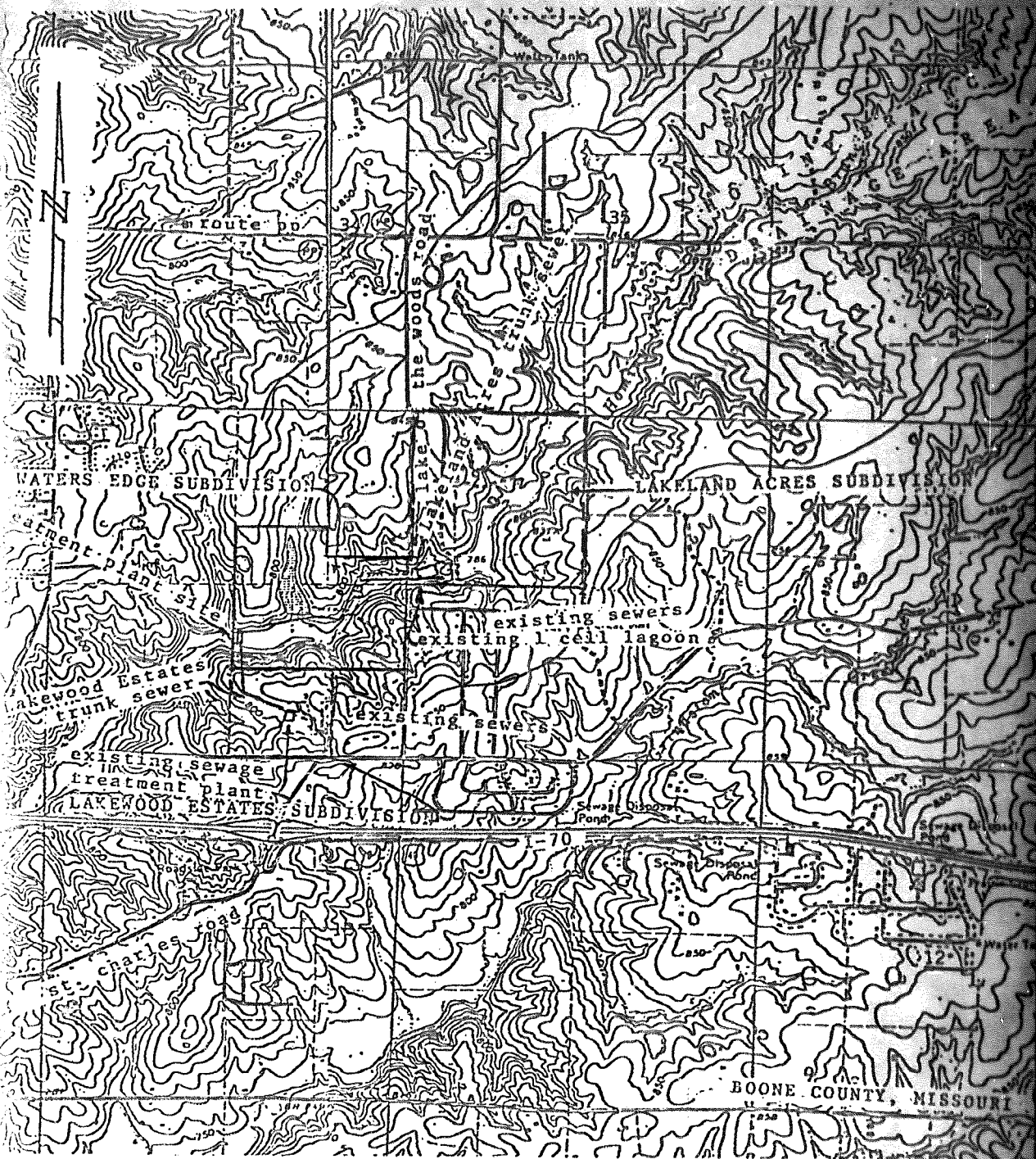

Existing Situation:

Waters Edge Subdivision is constructing a 160 lot development that requires wastewater treatment.

Lakeland Acres Subdivisions: Located adjacent on the east side and upstream of Waters Edge Subdivision. Existing facilities consist of 55 homes constructed or under construction. A plat has been submitted for an additional 80 lots. Existing lots are on sewers and treatment is by a single cell lagoon. Discharge from the lagoon will drain into the new lake in Waters Edge Subdivision.

Lakewood Estates: Located south and abutting with Waters Edge Subdivision. Existing development is 109 units. Additional land is available to development. The treatment plant that serves this area is reported to be heavily over loaded. Efforts are being made to construct a new treatment plant to replace the existing facility

Availability of service:

These areas are located within Boone County Regional Sewer District which currently does not operate, maintain or construct wastewater treatment facilities.

These areas are within the City of Columbia's designated 201 area. The City of Columbia does not have sufficient treatment capacity in the municipal system. Existing trunk sewers are located adjacent to I-70 in the Hominy Branch Area. Approved facility plan shows City trunks extending through all three areas. City of Columbia is constructing a new treatment plant with anticipated completion date 1983 \pm . Additional trunk sewers will be necessary and have not been designed or given a specific priority.



Alternatives:

1. Each Facility to construct, operate and maintain individual systems.
2. Combine treatment facilities into a single treatment plant.

Operation of each facility (3) causes three separate discharges and would require the use of 3 PSC Utility companies and duplication of operation equipment and personnel.

Combining treatment into one plant will eliminate 2 discharge points and allow each area to make use of the cost saving of not duplicating services and equipment.



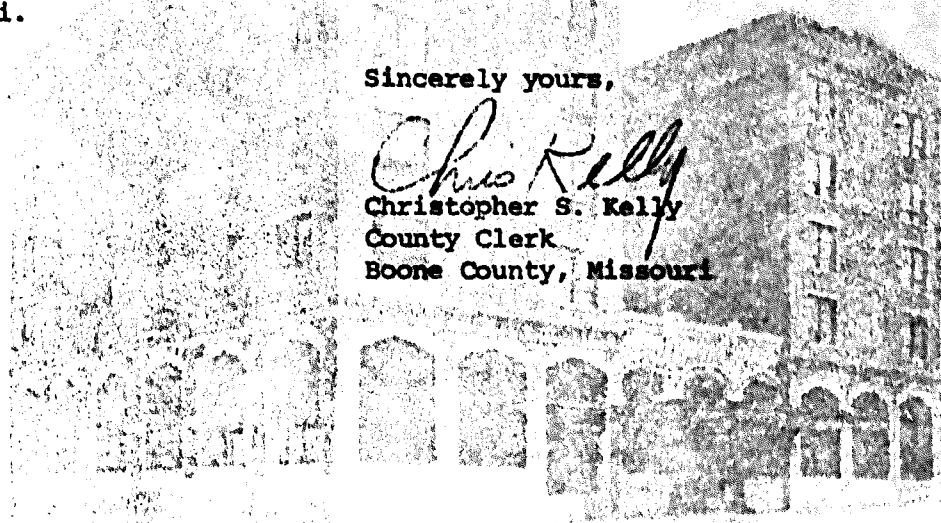

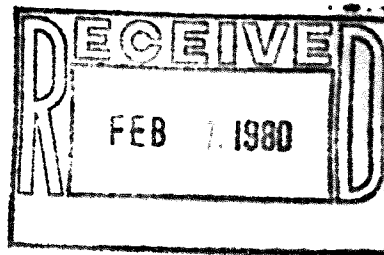

On February 21, 1980, an application for a sewer certificate was filed by Water's Edge Sewer Company.

I would appreciate it if you would have the proper staff people review the application to determine if it is complete enough to set for hearing. In the event the application is not complete enough for hearing, I would appreciate being advised as to what additional information should be requested.
